

EXTRA'S CORRESPONDENT SEARCH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The producers of EXTRA are looking for someone to be a correspondent for one broadcast of the show. That correspondent's segment will be videotaped in Las Vegas on or about April 12, 2008. Each entrant must complete an entry form found at www.extratv.com and submit a video of himself/herself that will show why he/she should be chosen as that one-time EXTRA correspondent (see Video Submission Guidelines). In order to apply to be a participant in the correspondent search selection process, you must meet the following eligibility requirements.

1. You must be at least 21 years of age on the date of application. You must submit your complete application between February 18, 2008 and 11:59 P.M. Eastern Time on March 24, 2008. Videos submitted via the Internet must be submitted between February 14, 2008 and 11:59 P.M. Eastern Time on March 24, 2008. Videos submitted via U.S. mail must be submitted on DVD and must be postmarked no later than March 24, 2008. One (1) video submission per person. You acknowledge that the video submission and the participant application become the sole and exclusive property of the producers and will not be returned to you. Finalists will be notified on or about April 1, 2008.
2. You must be a legal resident of, and physically reside in, one of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia (but excluding US territories, possessions, protectorates and foreign-based U.S. military installations and embassies).
3. You must have a valid, government-issued driver's license or other proof of age.
4. You must be able to travel, at EXTRA's expense, (a) to Las Vegas on or about April 9, 2008, (b) travel to Los Angeles on or about April 11, 2008, (c) return to Las Vegas on or about April 11; and (d) remain in Las Vegas through at least April 12, 2008.
5. You must not be a candidate for public office. You must agree not to become a candidate for public office until one (1) year after the initial broadcast of the episode of EXTRA in which you appear.
6. Neither you any member of your immediate family or anyone living in your household (whether related or not) may be or may have been within the last year an employee, officer, director or agent of any of the following: TTT West Coast, Inc., EXTRA, Time Warner, Warner Bros. Entertainment, Telepictures Productions, Inc., OpBiz, LLC d/b/a Planet Hollywood Resort & Casino, any Planet Hollywood property, broadcast licensees of EXTRA and all of their respective partners, parent companies, divisions, subsidiaries, affiliates, trustees, franchisees, licensees, distributors, advertising, promotion and public relations

agencies and their respective officers, directors, employees, agents, independent contractors, representatives and agencies. In addition, Producers reserve the right to render ineligible any person whom Producers determine, in their sole discretion, is sufficiently connected with the production, administration, judging or distribution of the Program such that his/her participation in the correspondent search could create the appearance of impropriety.

7. You understand that by completing and submitting the Las Vegas correspondent application, you acknowledge, accept and assume all risks known or unknown of any nature that may arise in any way from or relate to your participation in the correspondent search including, without limitation, risks associated with traveling to and from various locations to participate in that search.
8. If selected as a participant you must execute prior to your participation in the correspondent search any additional waivers and release agreements required by Producers or any of their licensees, successors or assigns including, without limitation, a release of liability/publicity release.
9. You have never done or been involved with anything that, if exposed, might reflect negatively on you or the producers or EXTRA (including, without limitation, any illegal or otherwise wrongful conduct), if you are chosen as a participant in the correspondent search.
10. If you are chosen to participate in the correspondent search, you acknowledge that in the event you are unable or unwilling to be available as required by the producers, or if you elect not to participate in the correspondent search prior to its commencement, the producers may disqualify you, in Producer's sole discretion. If you elect not to participate or the producers disqualify you, you acknowledge that the producers may substitute an alternate participant in its sole discretion.
11. You must have read and you must meet and agree to be bound by these Eligibility Requirements. You must complete the correspondent search application honestly and accurately.
12. You must be willing to be interviewed via telephone by the producers in order to determine your eligibility as a participant in the correspondent search.
13. If selected as a participant for the correspondent search, you must be willing to be filmed and interviewed 24/7 during the search process in Las Vegas and Los Angeles and you must be willing to grant to the producers the right to use that footage as part of EXTRA's programming. You must also be willing to appear on one episode of EXTRA as a correspondent to be videotaped in Las Vegas on or about April 12, 2008. Finally, you must be willing to grant producers permission to license any and all footage of you obtained during the correspondent search for use by Planet Hollywood as part of its in-house promotion for EXTRA.
