

## **THE EXTRA CORRESPONDENT SEARCH VIDEO SUBMISSION GUIDLINES**

As part of your application to be a participant in The EXTRA Correspondent Search you must submit a video of yourself explaining why you would make a good EXTRA correspondent (the “Video” or “Video Submission”). These guidelines explain what you can and cannot do in your Video Submission.

You may upload a compressed video (with a maximum running time of one (1) minute) in either Quicktime or Flash.

Each applicant is solely responsible and liable for his/her Video Submission. Each participant must own the rights to each and every element the participant includes in the Video as well as the right to grant to EXTRA all of the authorization, permissions, approvals, consents, rights and licenses that will allow EXTRA to utilize the Video in any format, in whole or in part, and in any and all markets and media in perpetuity throughout the world without the payment of any consideration to any person or entity. If an applicant does not exclusively own all of these rights, the applicant must so inform EXTRA upon submitting the Video and must specifically note what element(s) in the Video are not owned or licensed to the applicant.

By submitting the Video each applicant represents and warrants that the Video does not violate the rights of any other party, any law or regulation or infringe upon or misappropriate any intellectual property, privacy, publicity or other rights of any party. No Video may contain defamatory words/statements (including words or symbols that are widely considered offensive to individuals of a certain race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation or socioeconomic group). No Video may contain threats to any person, place, business or group, must not contain clothing or adornments which display any commercial/corporate advertising (including but not limited to corporate logs, brand names, slogans, trademarks, political, personal and religious statements, or portrays or depicts any person, living or dead). The Video may not contain indecent behavior, profanities or obscenities including, but not limited to, nudity or pornography.

No other person may appear with applicant in the Video unless applicant has first obtained the written consent of the other person to be videotaped for inclusion in the Video and for EXTRA to use and broadcast, and authorize others to use and broadcast, their name, likeness and image on EXTRA, on the EXTRA web site and for publicity, promotion and advertising in connection with the Extra Correspondent Search including in one or more Planet Hollywood Resorts & Casinos. Participant will make those written consents available to EXTRA on EXTRA's request. If other persons featured in a Video are considered minors in their state of residence, that person's parent/legal guardian must sign said consent. PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MAY NOT APPEAR IN A VIDEO unless that person is the child or ward of the participant.

No music (including, without limitation, music playing in the background at the location where a Video is being videotaped) may be included in any Video. The applicant may not sing a song or play a musical instrument in the Video.

In consideration of EXTRA's giving each applicant an opportunity to be considered for the EXTRA Correspondent Search and in further consideration of EXTRA considering each applicant as a potential participant in the EXTRA Correspondent Search, each applicant agrees, at all times, to defend, indemnify and hold harmless TTT West Coast, Inc., EXTRA, Time Warner, Warner Bros. Entertainment, Telepictures Productions, Inc., OpBiz, LLC d/b/a Planet Hollywood Resort & Casino, any Planet Hollywood property, broadcast licensees of EXTRA and all of their respective partners, parent companies, divisions, subsidiaries, affiliates, trustees, franchisees, licensees, distributors, advertising, promotion and public relations agencies and their respective officers, directors, employees, agents, independent contractors, representatives and agencies (collectively, the Search Entities) from and against any and all claims, actions, damages, losses, lawsuits, actions, costs (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees, court costs and disbursements) and expenses arising directly or indirectly from applicant's submission of the Video and/or the Search Entities' use and exploitation of the Video, or any portion thereof, in any and all markets and media now known or hereafter devised or discovered throughout the universe.
