LAWSUIT FILED AGAINST LINDSAY LOHAN FOR OUTRAGEOUS CAR CHASE

On the evening of July 23-24, 2007, Lindsay Lohan terrorized two women in Santa Monica. Lohan assaulted the women by driving an SUV toward them in an aggressive threatening manner and then chasing them through Santa Monica streets at a high rate of speed until the women were able to get to the safety of the Santa Monica Police Department where Lohan was arrested. Tracie Rice, one of the women in the car Lohan chased will file a civil lawsuit this morning seeking damages from Lindsay Lohan based on this extreme and outrageous conduct.

The complaint, which recounts the factual details about Lohan's actions that night and the damage these actions has caused Ms. Rice, will be posted on the Schonbrun DeSimone Seplow Harris and Hoffman website as soon as it is filed with the Court: www.sdshh.com.

Since the incident, Ms. Rice has not spoken out publicly. Attached is a public statement by Ms. Rice about this incident and her reasons for bringing this lawsuit. She will not make further public comments at this time.

Ms. Rice is being represented by Paul Hoffman and Benjamin Schonbrun of the Law Firm of Schonbrun De Simone Seplow Harris & Hoffman LLP. They will be available to respond to questions about the lawsuit.

STATEMENT OF TRACIE RICE

Lindsay Lohan's actions on the evening of July 23-24th put me through one of the most frightening experiences of my life. What Miss Lohan did that night was extremely dangerous and reprehensible. Someone could easily have been killed or seriously hurt because of her irresponsible decisions that evening. Her actions showed a complete disregard for my safety and well-being and for that of the entire community.

Though I understand Ms. Lohan has personal problems and has been treated for substance abuse, I believe that she must be held accountable for her actions that evening. I intend to cooperate fully with the District Attorney's Office to ensure that Ms. Lohan is held accountable for her actions under the criminal justice system. I hope that she will also receive the help she needs to rehabilitate herself fully in connection with those proceedings.

Reluctantly, I have decided to bring a civil action against Ms. Lohan for the enormous damage she has done to me by her conduct that evening. It is my sincere hope that the civil lawsuit will ensure that Miss Lohan is held fully accountable for her actions and will impress upon her that she cannot continue to act in a manner that puts the public at such peril.
